City Council Meeting Minutes

Mayor Cox called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Council Members present: Georgie Eggleston, Braden Meyers, Dave Houston, Terry Tyler, Ricky Yeager.

Mayor Cox asked for the approval of the August 4th agenda for the meeting. Tyler moved to approve the August 4th agenda. Eggleston second. Motion passed 5/0.

Mayor Cox recommended the approval of the July 7th City Council meeting minutes. Meyers moved to accept the minutes for the July 7th meeting. Houston second. Motion passed 5/0.

Mayor Cox asked for a motion to approve the July 22nd Special Budget meeting minutes. Yeager moved to accept the minutes from the Special Budget meeting. Tyler second. Motion passed 5/0.

Yeager moved to accept the warrants/bill that is presented with the agenda. Tyler second. Motion passed 5/0.

Public Comments:

Jessica Harris came before the council asking for some forgiveness on her water bill due to a water leak that had taken place. The council is willing to forgive \$250.00 of the \$599.00 bill. And to give her 90 days to pay off the remaining amount of the bill. Yeager moved. Tyler seconded, and the motion passed 5/0.

Jeff Freeman presented an update on the improvements made to the Brownfield Business.

Martha Newkirk, representing Coffey County Cancer Foundation, came to the council asking if they would be a sponsor for the Coffey-Health Foundation Golf Classic. Tyler moved to donate \$500.00. Yeager second. The motion passed 5/0.

Mayors Report:

Mayor Cox gave an update on the nuisance properties to the council.

Eggleston moved to schedule the September meeting to the 2nd due to the holiday. Houston second. The motion passed 5/0.

Superintendent reports: Aaron said he is working on finishing the installation of the new water meters, specifically the problematic meter. Before Jeff leaves for the summer, Aaron intends for him and Jeff to trim the trees that are overhanging the streets. Trim trees above streets.

City clerk's report: Kim reported that the Solid Waste cost will rise 5% in September.

Old/New business that the council would like to address:
