

City of LeRoy
Special Budget Hearing
Nuisance Hearing
August 11, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Council Members Present: Ricky Yeager, Terry Tyler, Georgia Eggleston, Braden Meyers, and Dave Houston.

Attendees:

Kevin and Katie Bowen, Rose Yoho, and Ryan Yoho.

Mayor Cox asked for a vote to approve the proposed meeting agenda for August 11. Eggleston moved to approve the proposed agenda. Houston second. Motion passed 5/0.

Mayor Cox closed the regular meeting and opened the Budget Hearing for any public comment. After hearing no comments from the public, Mayor Cox asked for a vote to approve the 2026 Budget. Tyler moved to approve the 2026 Budget. Meyers second the motion passed 5/0. Mayor Cox closed the Budget hearing.

Mayor Cox called the hearing to order on nuisance vehicles located at 1441 F Street, LeRoy, Kansas. Mayor Cox presented evidence of vehicles. Rose Yoho stated that one of the three vehicles is tagged, has a registration, and is currently on the tax roll. She would like more time to sell the white truck, which is also on the tax roll. The third vehicle is considered a farm wagon, which she argues should not be classified as a vehicle. Miss Yoho is planning an auction and requests a six-month grace period. Mayor Cox recommended moving ahead with Resolution 2025-5. The council will need proof of registration and tags for any of the vehicles within 10 days. If not received, the council will proceed with the removal of the cars. Tyler moved to pass Resolution 2025-5. Yeager second. Mayor Cox called for a vote, which passed 4/1. Eggleston voting no.
