

LeRoy City Council

Meeting Minutes

July 7, 2025

Mayor Cox called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Council members present: Braden Meyers, Georgia Eggleston, David Houston, Terry Tyler, Ricky Yeager.

Mayor Cox requested a motion to approve the proposed agenda for July 7, 2025. Tyler moved to approve the agenda, and Eggleston second. Motion passed 5/0.

Mayor Cox then asked for a motion to approve the warrants and bills presented with the July 7 agenda. Eggleston moved to accept the warrants and bills, Tyler second. The motion passed unanimously, with a vote of 5-0.

Public Comments:

Jeff Freeman – Updated the council on the construction for the Brownfield Building.

Kimberly Skillman from TrustPoint Insurance presented a dividend check to the council from EMC, totaling \$3,793.29.

Scheduled Visitors:

John Mattox would like to obtain the council's approval to extend his culvert in his driveway by an additional 10 feet. Mayor Cox asked if there was a motion to approve the new culvert, with Aaron Copeland inspecting the project before its completion. Yeager moved to approve the culvert as proposed, and Meyers second. The motion passed 5-0.

Lauren Hall presented a request to the council for a donation to the 2025 Heroes Pull. This event is a fundraiser for the Special Olympics and is part of the Law Enforcement Torch Run in Coffey County. Of the funds raised, 20% will go to COF Training Services. Yeager proposed a donation of \$250. Tyler second. Mayor Cox asked for a vote. Motion died for lack of movement. Yeager then moved to donate \$500.00 to the Coffey County Heroes Pull, and Meyers second. Motion passes 5/0.

Mikel Duffy sought permission from the council to connect water services to 701 12th Street so he could proceed with installing his house. Yeager suggested that Mikel be allowed to move his home to this property, place it on a cement foundation, and connect it to utilities. Eggleston seconded the motion, which then passed unanimously with a 5-0 vote.

Crystal Decker appeared before the council to discuss this year's LeRoy's Homecoming event. The theme this year is " Let the Good Time Roll. " Crystal is requesting a donation of \$3,000.00. Houston moved to donate \$3,000.00 to the Homecoming event, and Meyers second. The motion passed 5/0.

Tom and Tammy Cox appeared before the council regarding a dog that was brought back into the city, which is a direct violation of a court order.

Mayors Report:

Mayor Cox would like Aaron to contact Tony from Mcquire Iron and determine the start date of the water tower project.

Mayor Cox recommended that the city council approve the bid from Killough Construction for patching and crack filling the city streets, amounting to \$143,058.00. Houston moved to accept Killough Construction's bid, and Tyler second. The motion passed, 5-0.

Mayor Cox recommended passing Resolution 2025-3. Tyler moved Meyers second. Motion passed 5/0

Mayor Cox asked for a motion to approve Resolution 2025-4. Yeager moved to approve Resolution 2025-4. Eggleston second. Motion passed 5/0.

Old/New Business, the council would like to address:

Tyler moved to donate \$300.00 to the Smoke on the River BBQ event. Meyers second. Motion passed 5/0.

Meyers moved to adjourn the meeting. Eggleston second. Motion passed 5/0.
